Q1. WHO WILL BE THE JUDGES?

This year s Rodeo Days Chili Cook-off will be judged by all of the customers/patrons of Clover Square Village and local residents.

Q2. HOW DOES THE RATING SYSTEM WORK?

First, a CHILI PASSPORT will be designed and then distributed at the event. Each customer/taster/judge will travel around the event tasting as many chili s as they can and they will rank them. For judging purposes the top ranked Chili from each category (Amateur vs Professional) passport submitted to the organizers will be tallied and ranked with 3 top winners from the Amateur and Professional Categories. The ballots will be tallied and announced at the end of the event. We are asking that merchants consider providing a prize or gift certificate to be used in a draw just prior to Chili Trophy Announcements.

Q3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

In order to get all the participants names printed on the Passports, we need to know who will be participating at least a week in advance. More importantly, there is a need to fill out the Fraser Health Temporary Food Premise Application that has been provided which is due to 14 days prior to the event.

Q4. WHAT ARE THE RULES?

- a. Chili Cook-off open to the public at 4:30pm. Set up time: 3:30pm**
- b. Make lots of Chili if you want a better chance to win. (4-5 gallons recommended)**
- c. You can provide refreshments to cool things down.**
- d. PLEASE DO NOT BRING OR SERVE ANY ALCOHOL!**
- e. Keep all extension cords secured with tape to avoid any tripping potential**
- f. Keep all hot pots and serving units back out of harms way and reaching hands.**
- g. Professional entries that have an existing Health Operating Permit can cook their entries in their kitchens but they must submit the attached Fraser Health Temporary Permit Application to attend the event.**
- h. Amateur entries must make arrangements to cook their entries at our Amateur Host Kitchen located at the Pacific Community Church located at 5337 180 Street, Surrey Call Matthew Campbell at (604) 833-4075 to make arrangements. They will give you a time slot at the Community Kitchen.**

THE MOST IMPORTANT RULE OF ALL IS TO HAVE FUN AND THANK YOU FOR KEEPING THE RODEO SPIRIT ALIVE IN CLOVERDALE.

Participating merchants are required to supply their own cooking equipment, ingredients, etc.
